Moving to the Pinot Noirs, the 2017 Pinot Noir La Encantada Vineyard was mostly destemmed and spent 16 months in 40% new French oak. Its medium ruby/purple color is followed by a fruit-forward bouquet of ripe cherries and strawberries, spice, and smoked apple-wood, with just a hint of classic Sta. Rita Hills salinity and marine-like nuances. Rounded, supple, beautifully textured, and balanced, with integrated acidity, it's a rocking wine from this estate.
